



Commercial Animal Establishment Inspection Report

SANITATION & SAFETY

- Excreta removed. Primary enclosures sanitized at least 3 to 4 times a week.
- Cages, rooms & hard surface pens or runs sanitized; gravel, sand or dirt removed as necessary.
- Premises kept clean and in good repair. Effective pest control program.

WATERING

- Water accessible at all times; receptacles clean and sanitize regularly.

FEEDING

- Fed at least once a day, more often if required to provide adequate veterinary care. Approved food source.
- Accessible food receptacles are located to minimize contamination. Feed pans durable and clean, sanitized daily. Dry food for self-feeders, sanitized, clean.

FACILITIES

- Housing facilities structurally sound and in good repair. Hot & cold water provided to clean indoor housing facilities and primary enclosures.
- Suitable food and bedding provided and stored in facilities adequate to provide protection from insects and rodents. Refrigeration provided for perishable foods, medications, and vaccines.
- Provisions made for removal and disposal of animal and food wastes, bedding, dead animals, and debris. Disposal facilities maintained in sanitary condition.
- Washroom facilities, including sink and toilets, with hot & cold water, conveniently available for cleaning purposes to maintain personal hygiene among caretakers. Large sink or tub shall be available for washing utensils, equipment, and facilities.

INDOOR FACILITIES

- Sufficiently heated and cooled. Between 60 and 85 degrees F. Adequately ventilated.
- Ample lighting. Primary enclosed provide optional shade.
- Interior walls, ceiling and floor surfaces constructed with non-absorbent materials.
- Drainage system connected to sanitary sewer system, housing facilities maintained clean and sanitary.

OUTDOOR FACILITIES

- Adequate size (see regulations). Sufficient shade. Animals kept outside provided access to shelter to remain dry during rain and snow. Outdoor facilities constructed to drain.

PRIMARY ENCLOSURES

- Good repair, size, easily cleanable, litter for cats.

CLASSIFICATION & SEPARATION

- Animals housed in same primary enclosures maintained in compatible groups.
- Restrictions: Adult female dogs/cats not housed in same enclosure with males, except for breeding purposes. Vicious disposition. Dogs not with cats, or dogs/cats with any other animals. Animals under quarantine or treatment for communicable disease separated.
